



Convention Press Policy

The Canadian Psychological Association (CPA) welcomes media participation at its 75th Annual Convention. The following policies are in place for registered members of the press attending the convention.

Convention Admission

Media are highly encouraged to pre-register by e-mailing or calling the Canadian Psychological Association. To register, download the registration form, fill in the appropriate information, and return with the appropriate credentials to Tyler Stacey-Holmes at styler@cpa.ca or fax to 613-237-1674. The advanced press registration deadline is Monday June 2nd, 2014. Any registrations received after that date will be processed onsite. Note, however, that media, and all convention participants, must be registered in order to gain access to the convention activities and sessions.

Media must wear the CPA's media badge given to them in their convention registration kit. Badges are required of all convention participants for entry into sessions and must be worn at all times.

Registered press will have complimentary access to poster sessions that will give the broadest overview of the kinds of research and activities in which psychologists in Canada are engaged. A schedule of Poster Sessions will be made available in all press kits.

Photography, Video Taping, and Audio Recording

CPA has the following policies regarding the use of video and audio recording equipment at the 75th Annual CPA Convention, 2014:

- Any photographs, videotape or audiotape must be arranged with the consent of the presenter, author or any participants. Reproduction of any copyrighted material without prior consent of the author or presenter is strictly prohibited.
