Learning Disabilities (LD) are the largest group (over 40%) of identified exceptionality in the Ontario school system. Having co-occurring mental health challenges makes it more difficult for parents and educators to undersatnd and support students who are struggling with these issues.

A presentation on LD by Grace Labao-Martins (TCDSB Psychology) will be accompanied by a documentary (a joint project of TCDSB and Integra) showcasing the voices of young people who share their experiences living with LD and mental health problems. By sharing their strength-based stories we hope to increase understanding and empathy to promote healthier learning environments for all youth with LD. The film will be followed by Q&A by a panel including Dr. Marjory Phillips, Director of Clinical Services & Community Education at Integra, Dr. Maria Kokai, Chief Psychologist at TCDSB, as well as Valerie and Elizabeth Lancia, who both appear in the film.
