## Are you eligible?

If you're a student, in any year of study at a Canadian high school, then you can enter. You must have completed, or are completing, a science project in 2010/2011 that examines some aspect of human or animal behaviour, thinking or feeling (psychology).

## What do you need to include in your submission?



1. The title of your science project.
2. Contact information, including your name, email address, phone number, the name of your high school, and your grade. Also include contact information (including name, email address and phone number) of a parent or legal guardian.
3. A scientific summary of your project. Using a maximum of 250 words, describe the topic of your project, the hypothesis you tested and the method you used to answer the question, the results you obtained and the conclusions you reached.



## How do you make a submission?

Your Abstract should be submitted as a Word or PDF document and emailed to [publicrelations@cpa.ca](mailto:publicrelations@cpa.ca) by April 1st, 2011.

*Any late or incomplete submissions will be disqualified from entry.*

## When will the winners be announced?

Our panel of psychologists (members of CPA's Scientific Affairs Committee) will select 1 winner and up to 2 runners-up from the submitted Abstracts. Selections will be made by April 30, 2011 and winners will be notified.

Those selected will be invited to attend the 72nd annual convention of the Canadian Psychological Association on June 2 to 4, 2011 in Toronto, Ontario. The winner and runner(s)-up will participate in a symposium to present their work.

The winner and runner(s)-up will be given up to \$500 each by the CPA to support the costs of travel and accommodation to attend the convention. Prizes for the winner and runner(s)-up will be provided by Scotiabank.
