The Board of Directors of the Canadian Psychological Association has opened nominations for the Editorship of Canadian Journal of Experimental Psychology for the years 2013-2016.

Candidates should be available to start receiving manuscripts in 2012, to prepare for issues to be published in 2013.

The Canadian Journal of Experimental Psychology is published in collaboration with Canadian Society for Brain, Behaviour and Cognitive Science (BBCS) within a printing agreement with the American Psychological Association (APA).

Editors are normally members of both the Canadian Psychological Association and the Canadian Society for Brain, Behaviour and Cognitive Science.

To nominate candidates, prepare a brief statement of approximately one page in support of each nomination. **Nominations, accompanied by the nominee's vitae, should be submitted before August 1st, 2012.** Electronic nominations are preferred and should be sent to executiveoffice@cpa.ca, with *Publications Committee Chair, CJEP* in the subject line of the email message.
