INSTRUCTIONS FOR DIGITAL POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Posters will be grouped by topic, numbered, and listed in the Abstract book. The number assigned to your presentation in the Abstract book corresponds to the **Digital Poster Board** which you must use. Poster sessions on Thursday, Friday and Saturday will be scheduled for at least two 1-hour 55-minute time periods. Because of schedule constraints, FIFTEEN MINUTES will be allowed during your scheduled presentation time for setup and dismantle: 10 minutes to upload your presentation and 5 minutes to remove them.

**PLEASE BE AT YOUR ASSIGNED SPACE ON THE DAY AND TIME SPECIFIED IN YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER TO PRESENT YOUR POSTER. YOUR POSTER WILL BE ONLY DISPLAYED FOR THE TIME SPECIFIED IN YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER.

PREPARATION OF POSTERS:

Your poster will be presented on a 52" Sharp LCD screen. This cutting-edge medium will allow you to display 'a poster' as a series of images, with either times or manual (via remote control) advancing from image to image.

You will need to prepare your poster either as one image or as a series of images, each measuring 1920 pixels by 1080 pixels (an aspect ratio of 16×9), save it either as a .jpg or .jpeg file at 72 ppi (pixels per inch), with files named to ensure their proper display order

(e.g., A_CPA12Name.jepg, B_CPA12Name.jpeg). Save your poster on a USB drive and bring it to Halifax.
