The Children and Youth with Complex Care Needs (CYCCN) is a program of Provincial Services Division of the Ministry of Children and Family Development and provides residential, non-residential, outreach and ancillary services through intervention and stabilization plans for children and youth with Complex Care Needs.

Through a multi-disciplinary approach, the program's objective is to collaboratively enhance the capacity of communities to stabilize and build capacity employing Complex Care Intervention plans for these challenging children and youth through a closer to home focus.

The Licensed Psychologist will be responsible for completion of independent comprehensive psychological assessments of youth with significant and complex behavioral, trauma, developmental, attachment and psychiatric challenges referred to the Provincial CYCCN Program MCFD Child Safety Services for development of a comprehensive intervention and stabilization plan. You will also collaborate to provide clinical consultation to Provincial Tertiary and Secondary residential staff as well as Complex Care Intervention MCFD and contracted staff at the local level, caregivers, community agencies in the interpretation, implementation, and application of the psychological assessment report and community intervention and stabilization plan.
