Central Health is looking for an enthusiastic professional to join our Mental Health and Addictions Team.

Central Health is located in the heart of Newfoundland, with the geographical area encompassing more than half of the total land mass of the island (41,499km²). It has a natural beauty, boasting boreal forests and an abundance of rugged coastlines. The interior is covered with huge stands of birch, spruce and pine, provides a vast wilderness that houses a variety of flora and fauna for the outdoor enthusiast. With its scores of bays, big and small and dotted with islands, the northeast coast attracts humpback whales and towering icebergs each spring.

Central Health is the second largest regional health authority in Newfoundland and Labrador, serving a population of approximately 100 000 and offering a full continuum of health care services that are disbursed throughout the region. Our total workforce exceeds 3 000 individuals. Through a population health approach we work to promote healthy individuals and healthy communities.

We invite applications for a permanent full-time Clinical Psychologist III position located in Grand Falls-Windsor, Newfoundland and Labrador. Applicants will have a doctoral-level degree in Clinical Psychology, with specialized training as outlined below.

Definition of Work:

This leadership position is responsible for the assessment and treatment of outpatient, inpatient (medical and psychiatric), and long-term care residents in the Central Region. Primary responsibilities include geropsychological and neuropsychological assessments. This dynamic position involves a diverse range of referral questions and assessment approaches across the lifespan. The Clinical Psychologist III will be involved in clinical supervision and the development of an internship program for doctoral-level students. Research and program development is strongly encouraged and supported. The incumbent will be committed to safety and partner with all team members to improve worker and patient safety by integrating safety into work practices, identifying risks and implementing improvements.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 5 years experience working with clients with mental health and/or addictions needs within the last 7 years preferred
- Doctorate Degree in Psychology from an accredited university
- Registered or eligible for registration with the Newfoundland and Labrador Board of Examiners in Psychology
- Satisfactory Child, Youth and Family Services Records Check
- Satisfactory record of work performance and attendance is required
- Use of a private vehicle and valid driver's license are a condition of employment
