- psychological consultation to multi-disciplinary teams, including psychiatrists, social workers/family therapists, child and youth workers, and teachers
- supervision of psychology professionals (e.g., clinicians in supervised practice for licensure in Ontario, clinical psychology interns, and/or psychometrists), possibly to include didactic teaching of one or more core clinical skills

Qualifications:

- a **Ph.D.** in clinical psychology and/or child-clinical/school psychology
- Ontario registration as a psychologist with declared competence in clinical psychology and school psychology, including assessment, consultation, and treatment with children and adolescents
- Competence in psycho-educational assessments (i.e., cognitive and achievement testing, as well as the administration and interpretation of a wide variety of psychological processing measures) with children and adolescents
