The Dialectical Behaviour Therapy Centre of Vancouver is seeking a registered psychologist or clinical or counseling psychology graduate (Ph.D. or Psy.D.) to become part of a growing private psychology practice. The DBT Centre of Vancouver was established in April 2007 and provides treatment for multi-problem, multi-diagnostic individuals, especially those struggling with borderline personality disorder (BPD). The centre includes nine part-time and full-time clinicians and provides services for adults, adolescents, and families, as well as training and consultation to other mental health providers. It offers a competitive salary and benefits package.

Job responsibilities include: individual and group DBT with adults and/or adolescents, administrative duties, participation on a DBT consultation team, and assistance with the development of a research program.

Requirements for this position include: significant training in cognitive-behavioral treatment, Ph.D. or Psy.D. in clinical or counseling psychology from a CPA or APA accredited program, completion of an APA or CPA accredited pre-doctoral internship, training and experience in the treatment of BPD, multi-problem clients, and/or suicidal individuals.

Preferred: training and experience with DBT, registration as a psychologist in B.C. or eligibility for registration in B.C., training and experience in assessment and structured interviewing.

Dr. Alex Chapman and Dr. John Wagner direct the DBT Centre of Vancouver. Both Drs. Chapman and Wagner received extensive training in DBT as post-doctoral fellows working with Dr. Marsha Linehan (who is the developer of DBT). They will provide ongoing training, consultation, and supervision in DBT. In addition, a competitive salary and benefits package is provided. The recreational and cultural opportunities in Vancouver are virtually unlimited, and Vancouver has recently been rated the #1 city to live in the world.
