




Selecting "I am an Author" will provide a dropdown with an option to "Submit Abstract"




3. Select "Submit Abstract" and then select a "Program Stream" from the dropdown list. Then select Next





4. Select the Category of Submission from the list below. When you have chosen the category of submission you wish to make, the page will then refresh.




5. Now you can proceed to choose from the different types of submission. Then select Next










6. Select Add Main Presenting Author. Then Select Next







- Background/rationale: (What is the rationale for your scientific study or program/policy? Information provided in this specific field will be
 provided to the reviewers to aid the assessment of all submissions.
- Methods: (What is the methodology underlying your scientific study or approach underlying your program/policy? Information provided in this specific field will be provided to the reviewers to aid the assessment of this submission.
- Results: (What analyses or evaluations were conducted and what did they show? Information provided in this specific field will be provided to the
 reviewers to aid the assessment of this submission.
- Conclusions: (What conclusions are you able to draw based on the results? Information provided in this specific field will be provided to the
 reviewers to aid the assessment of this submission.
- Action/Impact: (What actions, recommendations or impacts were made, implemented or evaluated? Information provided in this specific field will be provided to the reviewers to aid the assessment of this submission.






