Note that the policy renews on June 1st, 2023.

Individual PLI/CGL Package Coverage Highlights Include:

\$10M Professional Liability Insurance (PLI) per claim/aggregate limit

\$5M Commercial General Liability (CGL) per claim/aggregate limit

Your PLI also includes:

- \$300,000 Regulatory Legal costs (N/A for Student coverage)
- \$300,000 Criminal Defence reimbursement
- \$1M Abuse Legal Defence costs (however, coverage for damage awards no longer included)
- 2-year Extended Reporting Period
- And more

Please note that the individual PLI policy no longer includes coverage for Privacy Event and Cyber Liability and Network Security costs. Practitioners who deliver telepsychology services and/or those responsible for maintaining and safeguarding confidential client information are encouraged to purchase the separate Cyber Security and Privacy Liability insurance to address this exposure.
