## What is TUTOR-PHC?

This innovative **one-year certificate program** (May 2020 – April 2021) in primary health care research skills and interdisciplinary theory and processes includes:

- An on-site Symposium in the Spring of 2020
- Two 3 week online research skill development workshops
- Two 7-8 week online interdisciplinary discussion groups
- Receive a year of mentorship from expert mentors across Canada
