- 2. Be a member of the CPA Health Psychology and Behavioural Medicine Section
- 3. Conduct research and/or practice in the field of health psychology or behavioral medicine (or a closely related field)
- 4. Attend the upcoming annual 2026 CPA conference in Montreal, QC and present a 30-minute talk if awarded

To be considered, send the following materials to Dr. Kharah Ross (kharahr@athabascau.ca):

- A 1-2 page nomination letter stating how they have made a significant contribution to health psychology and/or behavioral medicine in Canada. Note: you can apply as a nominee or onbehalf of a nominee, but the nomination letter must be written by someone other than the nominee;
- · Recent CV (any format); and
- 1 page indicating leaves of absence (optional)

## Deadline: January 10, 2026.

The winner will receive a \$500 cash prize and certificate acknowledging the honour, as well as recognition of their contributions at the next CPA conference within our Section program.
