Opportunities – ADULT SERVICES Winnipeg

Pain Psychologist. The Manitoba Pain Care Program, a multi-disciplinary, multi-site ‘hub-and-spoke’ provincial service is committed to evidence-based, integrated care for adults with chronic pain. Behavioural pain treatment, delivered through a stepped care approach, is at the centre of the newly expanded program’s model of care, coordinated with medical interventions. The pain psychologists on the team have an essential role and provide assessment, class-based, group and individual therapies, as well as program development and evaluation.

Bariatric Surgery Psychologist. The Centre for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery offers comprehensive pre-operative evaluation and post-operative follow up that aims to maximize patient long-term success following bariatric surgery. The Psychologist will provide pre-surgical readiness assessments, pre- and post-surgery psychological intervention, with opportunity for program development and evaluation.



Opportunities – CHILD SERVICES Winnipeg

Pediatric Neuropsychologist. As a member of the Child & Adolescent Psychology Consult service, the Psychologist works closely with pediatric neurology and neurosurgery teams at Children's Hospital. The Psychologist provides consult and assessment for a range of medical, surgical, and neurodevelopmental presentations, with opportunity to provide clinical treatment.

Transgender Health. The compassionate interprofessional team of pediatricians, nurses, psychologists and allied health staff in the GDAAY Clinic (Gender Diversity and Affirming Action for Youth) at Health Sciences Centre work with children and families to support transgender health. The child psychologist provided assessment, treatment and consultation; there is also opportunity for clinical program development.

Psychologists in the Manitoba health system hold medical staff appointments along with our physician colleagues, and enjoy well-established collaborations with medical, nursing and allied health professionals to provide innovative and effective care. CHP psychologists connect regularly with each other, whether based in Winnipeg or in rural or northern health regions, and have a respectful and caring community of professional practice.
