As first reported to the membership in 2012, the CPA will host the International Congress of Applied Psychology (ICAP) in Montreal, QC, from June 26-30, 2018. The theme for ICAP2018 – *Psychology: Connecting Science to Solutions* – was chosen to promote the exchange of science and science-based solutions among psychologists from around the globe. We are working with the International Association of Applied Psychology (IAAP) and MCI Canada to plan a world class event. We are pleased to provide our Sections with regular planning updates.

Congress Invited Speakers

We have convened an exciting lineup of congress-invited speakers that will be delivering State of the Art Lectures, Master Lectures, Keynote Addresses and Symposia. We have been <u>updating our website</u> as we receive new details from our confirmed speakers, many of whom were nominated by either a CPA Section or an IAAP Division.

Submissions and Review Update

The submission system closed mid-December! Many thanks to all of you for promoting ICAP amongst your members. We received 3x more submissions than the CPA's National Convention normally receives. ICAP2018 will feature <u>six exciting and different presentation formats</u> for the general program, including the now popular GIMME-5 sessions, and in-congress workshops. Featuring programming that will span five days and world-renowned speakers, ICAP2018 is sure to get you thinking about the field of psychology in new and exciting ways!

Many thanks to all Section Chairs, Review Coordinators and Reviewers who participated in the ever-important review process. Submission notifications began going out on February 9th, 2018.

Section-Invited Program

Registration: Early Bird Deadline is February 28, 2018

The registration system is <u>now open</u>! All CPA members will benefit from lower registration fees; however, **full members who register before the early bird deadline of February 28th will automatically receive an additional subsidy of \$100.** CPA student affiliates will receive a subsidy of \$75 regardless of when they register.

Pre-Congress Workshops

The CPA will be overseeing all Pre-Congress Workshops (PCWs) at ICAP2018 and we will feature 16 exciting workshops covering a range of topic areas offered in either English or French. <u>Registration for the PCWs</u> is now open!

Accommodations

There is no CPA-specific hotel for ICAP2018, but we have secured <u>room blocks at varying price points</u> at hotels within walking distance of the Palais des congrès. ICAP2018 is book-ended by two major holidays so book early.
