- Excellent interpersonal, clinical and communication skills, as well as organizational and time management skills
- Supervisory, conflict resolution and crisis management skills
- Knowledge of word processing, evaluation, computerized statistical programs and psychological scoring packages and the use of video conferencing is required
- Preference will be given to bilingual (French/English) candidates
