We also ask applicants to include a one-page statement about their experience working with a diverse student body and their contributions or potential contributions to creating/advancing a culture of equity and inclusion. In addition, applicants should arrange to have at least three confidential letters of recommendation submitted via email to <u>ubcpsycjobs@psych.ubc.ca</u>.

The positions are subject to final budgetary approval. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
