Job Summary:

This unique position involves advanced-level practice within a large comprehensive cardiac rehabilitation program. The psychologist works as a member of an integrated interdisciplinary team. Activities include patient care, staff training, research, and program development. The psychologist delivers short-term psychotherapeutic services including assessment for treatment planning, case formulation, resource referrals, group psychoeducation, as well as individual and group therapy. Staff training involves case consultation and supervision regarding psychosocial issues, medical adherence, and behaviour change counseling. The psychologist also contributes to clinical research, outcome evaluation, and quality assurance activities with potential opportunities for academic publications and knowledge translation.

Applicants should have the following qualifications:

- Doctoral degree in Psychology, preferably from a program accredited by the Canadian Psychological Association and/or the American Psychological Association
- Registered, in the process of registration, or eligible for registration with the College of Alberta Psychologists
- Minimum three years professional practice experience
- Comprehensive training in clinical health psychology, behavioural medicine, or a related field
- Advanced skill in evidence-based individual- and group-based psychological intervention, with an emphasis on cognitive-behavioural therapy
- Knowledge and experience with case formulation and treatment planning among a psychologically and medically complex patient population
- Ability to facilitate psychoeducational groups with adult patients and their families
- Demonstrated comfort and ability to assess and intervene within a short-term, goal-oriented mental health model
- Knowledge and experience with program development and research design
- Competent in the delivery of clinical supervision and multidisciplinary training
- Ability to perform all duties in accordance with related legislation
- Demonstrated ability to work within a self-directed environment with minimal supervision
- Demonstrated ability to work with an interdisciplinary team
