Psychologist (x2) Work, Stress & Health Services Acute Care Program

Position Description

The Work Stress and Health Service is currently seeking a full-time, contract (12 months) and a casual Psychologist. The WSH is a unique service within CAMH in that it is revenue generating, working exclusively with third party partners. In this role, you will work as a member of a multidisciplinary team, primarily in the Psychological Trauma Program. This program is a specialized service providing assessment and outpatient treatment for individuals with post-traumatic stress disorder, depression, and other psychiatric disorders that are related to the workplace.

You will provide comprehensive assessments as well as evidence based treatment in both individual and group formats that will address psychological functioning, diagnosis and return to work. You will participate in multidisciplinary education and training, as well as have capacity to deliver training to external organizations; contribute actively to program development opportunities, and will be responsible for other duties as required, up to and including supporting other programs within the Acute Care Program in the role of Psychologist if needed. This position is currently located at 455 Spadina Avenue.

Qualifications

The candidate must be registered, or eligible for registration, with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. The successful candidate will have a doctoral degree in Psychology with 3 years clinical experience. You will have experience in evidenced based treatment for trauma and stressor-related disorders as well as mood, anxiety, and concurrent disorders. Experience in third party/WSIB assessments, and experience in pain assessment would be seen as great asset, as would experience in addictions and experience supporting specialty populations in third party claims. Significant experience in the administration of psychological assessments, including objective self-report instruments and structured diagnostic interviewing, are essential, with an emphasis on the SCID, MMPI-2, and PAI. Excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to work effectively in a dynamic team environment is essential to the success of this position. The successful candidate will also possess excellent organizational and communication skills and can work effectively within set contractual reporting deadlines. High degree of proficiency with computer-based programs (word processing, electronic communication, workload measures) is required. The capacity to work with clients of diverse ethnoracial and cultural backgrounds is required and proficiency in a second language would be considered an asset.
