

The Saskatchewan Health Authority has various opportunities for Ph.D. Psychologists within Mental Health and Addiction Community Services.

As part of a multidisciplinary team, the Ph.D. Psychologist provides a complex range of screening, triage, assessment, treatment and case coordination services. Positions are available for work primarily with children, adolescents and young adults requiring mental health and addictions services, or to work with the adult community mental health and addictions population. The Psychologist Ph.D. also provides program consultation and co-ordination, evaluation of clinical interventions, preceptor students in formal clinical practicum, and provides professional and public education regarding mental health and addiction issues and resources.

Education:

Recognized Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology. Must have a current practicing registration with Sask. College of Psychologists as a Doctoral Psychologist with an Authorized Practice Endorsement.

Experience:

One year (post-doctorate) recognized experience in working within community mental health and addiction services is preferred.
