The clinic is based on a scientist-practitioner model in psychology that utilizes evidence-based practices by various theoretical orientations and treatment modalities. We are partnered with the Child Psychology Internship Consortium (CPIC) and COPE Kids, which is a recently developed non-profit organization that aims to provide free access of psychological services to marginalized groups. Our practice also encourages personal and professional development, and provides a supportive and collegial work environment.
