Summary

This is a newly expanded permanent full time Psychologist position working exclusively in the Bloorview School Authority. Bloorview School Authority, located inside Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital, is an educational facility that provides innovative school programs to children and youth with special needs. Each year hundreds of children and young people from across Ontario benefit from our individualized educational programs, which are set up in conjunction with ongoing therapeutic and medical care. The psychologist will have the opportunity to work within a unique school as part of an interdisciplinary team. This team provides an early intervention program for children in Kindergarten and Grade 1 with a range of physical and communication disabilities. As this is a newly expanded position, the incumbent will have the opportunity to create and influence the program's development.

This is a permanent full time position with the flexibility to work between a 0.8 FTE to a 1.0 FTE, or 30 to 37.5 hours a week. This position is a 12-month a year position, however it does follow the academic calendar for school holiday closures and there is increased flexibility for time off during the summer months. The psychologist will be an integral part of Holland Bloorview's psychology practice and will be linked to the Hospital's practice council.

As a permanent full time employee of Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital, the successful candidate will have the opportunity to participate in Holland Bloorview's competitive benefit package, including health and dental coverage and participation in the Healthcare of Ontario Pension Plan (HOOPP).
