



Pediatric Clinical Neuropsychologist – Health Sciences Centre Shared Health & University of Manitoba

Clinical Health Psychology (CHP), Shared Health, in conjunction with the Department of Clinical Health Psychology (CHP) Max Rady College of Medicine, University of Manitoba invite applications for a Geographic Full-Time (GFT, contingent) Clinical Psychologist (Position #33466) with a flexible start date in Fall 2023, and opportunity to start earlier or later if needed. This permanent position integrates clinical and academic roles (typically 80% clinical; 20% applied clinical teaching/applied research). The successful applicant will be appointed to the Medical Staff of Shared Health, and will be appointed to the Department of Clinical Health Psychology, Max Rady College of Medicine, at the academic rank commensurate with experience, typically Assistant Professor. Current interns/residents are welcome to apply.

The position is based at Health Sciences Centre, Winnipeg. The Pediatric Clinical Neuropsychologist is part of CHP's Child & Adolescent Psychology Service, which consults to both the Children's Hospital pediatric clinics and to the Mental Health & Addictions child inpatient/outpatient services. In collaboration with interdisciplinary teams, the child neuropsychologist provides consultation and assessment for a range of presentations regarding neurological illness and injury (e.g., traumatic brain injury, epilepsy, cancer), pre/post neurosurgery, and complex neurodevelopmental disorders. Consultation can also include opportunity to provide intervention for health and mental health conditions, where appropriate training and experience.

Clinical Health Psychology (CHP) is unique in Canada, being both an academic department in the Max Rady College of Medicine and a provincially-led clinical service in the Manitoba health system, with a mandate to provide psychological services across a range of hospital and community sites in urban and rural/northern settings. As a member of CHP, the Psychologist joins a large team of dedicated psychologist colleagues across the province who provide mentoring, consultation, and collegial support.

Position Responsibilities:

- Neuropsychological assessment of children and youth
- Consultation to outpatient clinics and inpatient units
- Psychological intervention (e.g., individual, group, parent-mediated) for related health, mental health conditions, with opportunity for development of clinical programming.
- Clinical supervision and training in our CPA-accredited psychology residency program. Teaching of medical students and learners from other health professions.
- Applied clinical research.

Qualifications:

- Doctoral degree (PhD or PsyD) in Clinical Psychology or Neuropsychology from a CPA or APA-accredited clinical psychology training program, and completion of a CPA or APA accredited internship/residency.
- Registered or eligible for registration as a C.Psych. with neuropsychology competence by the Psychological Association of Manitoba www.cpmb.ca
- Education, training and experience in child & adolescent clinical psychology and neuropsychology; health psychology experience an asset.
- Education, training and experience in diagnostic evaluation and cognitive, and developmental assessment, including the administration and interpretation of standard psychological and neuropsychological tests and measures applicable to children and youth.

- Education and training in evidence-based psychological treatments for children an asset.
- Excellent interpersonal relationship skills, oral and written communication, and inter-professional teamwork skills.
- Satisfactory results of pre-employment criminal record, vulnerable person and child and adult abuse registry checks are required.

Salary and Benefits:

- Attractive salary schedule, with benefits package through the University of Manitoba, and relocation support.
- The Geographical Full Time (GFT) agreement provides the opportunity for on-site private practice.
- Supervision will be provided by the CHP Program for individuals registered at the C.Psych. Candidate level, until completion of registration requirements for independent practice as a C.Psych.
