### Psychologist/Neuropsychologist - FASD Assessment Clinic

Continuing Contract Position- 14hr/week

Anishnawbe Health Toronto, a fully accredited community health centre, offers access to health care practitioners from many disciplines including Traditional Healers, Elders and Medicine People. The Clinical Counsellor provides individual and group based counselling and case management in collaboration with the Primary Health Team.

#### Duties & Responsibilities:

- Working as part of an interdisciplinary team, the psychologist/neuropsychologist provides comprehensive neurodevelopmental assessment and consultation for children and youth with suspected/diagnosed FASD, using a variety of modalities in accordance with professional standards and the Canadian Diagnostic Guidelines for FASD.
- Conducting chart reviews, assessing appropriateness of referrals, conducting clinical/diagnostic interviewing, determining appropriate assessment battery, administering neuropsychological/psychological assessment measures (with the assistance of a psychometrist), scoring/interpreting assessment findings, taking a lead role in diagnostic formulation (of FASD and other relevant DSM-V disorders) and differential diagnosis
- Generate recommendations to target neurodevelopmental, mental health, family, social, and educational needs
- Lead role in interdisciplinary assessment report, verbally communicate assessment findings/diagnoses and related recommendations to children, youth, and families.
- Participate in monthly interdisciplinary team meetings, case conferences, provide ongoing consultation to families, schools, and other agencies (e.g., NCFST) regarding case formulation and treatment planning for children and youth with suspected/diagnosed FASD.

#### Required Education, Skills & Experience

- Registered Clinical Psychologist with 3-5 years of experience. Clinical Neuropsychology preferred.
- Current member in good standing with the College of Psychologists of Ontario.
- Demonstrated ability to complete psychological assessments and diagnosis.
- Knowledge of neurodevelopmental/brain-based disorders.
- Experience caring for children who have multiple vulnerabilities including cognitive/learning, physical, mental health, trauma and addictions.
- Awareness of and sensitivity to health issues specific to Indigenous community
- Knowledge of the Canadian Diagnostic Guidelines for FASD (Cook et al., 2015) and DSM-V diagnostic criteria, as well as implications for intervention.
- Commitment to ensuring that interventions are evidence-informed and/align with best practice approaches.
- Experience providing clinical supervision.
