Job Title: CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST

Primary Duties

Assessment Services: Conduct comprehensive psychological and neuropsychological assessments with children, adolescents and occasionally adults presenting with a range of cognitive, learning, developmental and clinical queries.

1. Determine appropriate battery of measures, administer, score and interpret standardized psychological measures in order to determine diagnosis based on DSM5 criteria and develop comprehensive recommendations aligned with best practice.
 - a. Expected workload 20-24 assessments per year
2. Conduct parent meetings, school consultations, in-class behavioural observations, and multidisciplinary review for the purpose of assessment or ongoing treatment planning
3. Plan and conduct 1:1 psychoeducational and clinical interventions to children and youth with clinical, developmental &/or behavioural disorders

Clinical Services: Delivery of psychology and clinical intervention services, including but not limited to the following services under the supervision of Clinical Manager/Director.

1. Assess, plan and deliver evidence-based therapeutic service to children, youth, and adults who present with an array of psychological and mental health problems.
 - a. Conduct Clinical Intake sessions with new clients, formulate case summary and treatment plan through the use of sound clinical knowledge, use of standard measures, and clinical supervision.

- b. Evaluate treatment interventions, seek consultation and revise according to the client's needs
 - c. Training and experience in use of evidence based intervention modalities
2. Maintain an active caseload, with 25 billable hours per week.
3. Present clinical cases at Clinical Team meetings for the purpose of peer supervision

1. Maintain the highest standard of confidentiality at all times
2. Maintain documentation in a timely manner using our EHR platform.
