Registered Psychologists and Clinical Psychologists are on Tier 1 of New Zealand's Green List which means you are eligible for the Straight to Residence Visa and can apply for New Zealand residency before you arrive, provided you have a job offer from a New Zealand

accredited employer in a role that meets the median wage requirements, and you hold occupational registration. This can either be us at Health NZ, or an NGO or community provider that we can put you in contact with, based on your job preferences.

Requirements

To work as a Clinical Psychologist or Registered Psychologist in our mental health and addiction sector, you must be eligible for Registration with the Psychologist Board of New Zealand including minimum of a Master's degree in Psychology from an accredited educational organisation and an accredited Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical Psychology or equivalent specialisation qualification. You have a minimum of two years post international registration in a mental health setting.
