SD 71 is located on the east coast of Vancouver Island in the traditional territory of the K'ómoks First Nation. Located within the Comox Valley is the City of Courtenay, the Town of Comox and the Village of Cumberland; each providing their own unique services and community cultures. The Comox Valley is a desirable place to live with great ocean beaches, golf, skiing, hiking, swimming and boating. In addition, the community has strong and vibrant arts and cultural programs.

The successful candidate will have:

- Minimum requirement of a Master's Degree in School Psychology or related field, with a focus on School Psychology, including graduate training and recent experience with administration, scoring and interpretation of up to and including Level C Cognitive, Academic, and Socio-emotional measures as part of the psycho-educational assessment process
- Eligible for membership with the BC Association of School Psychologists or registration with the College of Psychologists of British Columbia
- Demonstrated ability to provide consultation with parents, teachers and School Based Teams regarding student strengths and needs, educational implications and related strategies in line with RTI and Universal Design for Learning frameworks
- Demonstrated ability to provide in-service on assessment as well as strategies and interventions in line with the principles of Inclusive Education
- Knowledge of the BC Ministry of Education Special Education Policies and Procedures
- A valid BC Driver's Licence and vehicle as travel throughout the district is required
- Must be licensed with the College of Health and Care Professionals of BC
