Cariboo-Chilcotin School District (CCSD) is located in the Central Interior of British Columbia and includes the communities of Williams Lake, 100 Mile House, Dog Creek, Horsefly, Likely, Alexis Creek, Tatla Lake, Anahim Lake and Nemiah Valley. The School District is in a vast, spectacular geographic region of the province and is on the traditional and unceded territories of the Secwepemc, Tsilhqot'in, and Dakelh First Nations.
