SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST - 1.0 FTE CONTINUING

- Communicate assessment results and recommendations clearly to school teams and families.
- Work effectively within a multidisciplinary team, contributing to collaborative planning and decision-making.
- Perform other related duties as required.

- A Master's Degree in school/educational psychology or a related field with a focus on school psychology.
- Qualifications that meet the standard for membership in the British Columbia Association of School Psychologists.
